

## Congratulations to the 2019-2020 Undergraduate Research Contest Award Winners: Abby West and Devon Terry

The University Libraries Undergraduate Research Contest seeks to recognize and reward outstanding research conducted by undergraduate students at the University of Missouri.

This year the winner of the first place prize of a \$500 scholarship is Abby West, a junior studying political science. Her paper, "Saratoga Spells British Defeat," was written for Dr. Al Zuercher Reichardt's constitutional democracy course.
