




BACKGROUND


- The COVID-19 pandemic has uniquely impacted college students' mental health and well-being.













Have you canceled or not scheduled an appointment you would have had between February and June 2020?




Has your health care provider cancelled an appointment you would have otherwise had between February and June 2020?
